Town Manager Report

For the shred & pill event, we had about 4500 lbs of paper shredded, and the police collected about 10.5 lbs or 7875 pills.

The Spring Litter sweep, which ran from April 13 through April 27, and I did a robocall on this to see if anyone was interested, and we had a church youth group who signed up to pick up litter.

Just a reminder this week for the budget meeting on Thursday, May 9 we will meet at Kosta's at 8 for breakfast and then come back to town hall at 9 to start the meeting. I balanced the budget last week and got everything in there without a tax increase.

Not a lot more from Crown Castle on the wireless facilities they have 3 set up for Underwood Road right now and the most sensitive one is to go on Fanning Bridge Road somewhere, but they have not set a location as yet and have put it on hold for now. They are trying to minimize the impact.
