Research on retail rehabilitation grant programs - Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager

Town Manager Mark Biberdorf stated that he had reached out to one of the owners of The Plaza shopping center here in Fletcher, and he is willing to meet with us. Eric Rufa and I are going to meet with him sometime next week. I want to talk to them about what is going on with the town center project property and how it impacts what they have there and what we are trying to do and see what their long-term goals are. If you approve it, I wanted to see if they would be interested in grant opportunities.

Town Manager Report

I know I mentioned to you about a community shred day in the fall. I am waiting to hear back from First Citizens Bank Mitizi Reed about Friday, October 25th being the best day.

Councilmember Keith Reed said that October 25 was not going to work and that it looked like it would be Friday, October 18 instead.

Town Manager Mark Biberdorf stated that would work ok for us but, he was not sure about the schedule for the police department to have a pill drop, then he would have to look into that. We could still do just a shred event without a pill drop. The police department does have a medication drop box in their lobby that is well-used.

On the fall litter Sweep participation I will be getting a call-out in the next day or so to promote it. Christ School is volunteering to pick up litter so they will be by to get supplies to do this. We provide bags, vests and pick-up sticks.
