We were approved for the \$100,000 grant for the greenway expansion and, given the current condition of our greenways after the storm, this is not the best timing right now, but we have one year from notification to get the grant placed. I also received a call from Kieran Rowe from Conserving Carolina to see if we were interested in participating in a conservation easement along the creek.

On the wetlands' delineation, which is located to the north of town hall and behind, it is time to update our map. McGill will do an engineering analysis and the Army Core of Engineers have to approve any fill dirt in any places that would make the most sense for us.

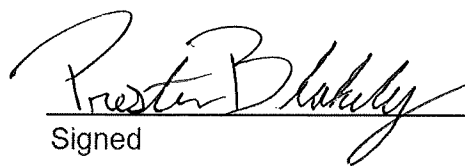
