Discussion Items

Presentation of plan for extension of Cane Creek Greenway - Ben Cathey, McGill Associates

Ben Cathey of McGill Associates went over the options for extending the Cane Creek Greenway.

Discussion Followed:

It has been recommended to complete section 3 (parking lot at Rockwell Drive to US-25) and section 4 (loop connector to section 3) and if the bids come in lower than expected, to possibly do section 1 (Fernleaf section to Railroad Bridge) as well.

Since Mayor Blakely and Councilmember Jim Player are absent from this meeting, Mayor Pro-Tem Trevor Lance has suggested that we bring this back at the December meeting so that they can have some input on this matter.

Instructions for update to the five-year capital improvement plan - Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager

Town Manager Mark Biberdorf stated that last week he went over all the instructions for the CIP update. The submissions from department heads will be due by November 26th. If council has any projects that you are interested in, please let me know. Jim did ask for the potential of additional lighting on the other ball fields in the park.

Discussion Followed:

Approval of grant submission from the Stormwater Off-Right-of-Way Grant Program - Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager

Town Manager Mark Biberdorf stated we received our first grant application from a homeowner at 96 Wilkie Way. The lowest bid for this project was \$6,110. This will increase if there is additional tree removal. Our advisory panel met on Thursday of last week to discuss this (myself, Public Works Director Jabbo Pressley and Mayor Pro-Tem Trevor Lance). We went over this and are comfortable with it. If this approved the town pays 90% and the homeowner pays the other 10%, which is part of the agreement.

Mayor Pro-Tem Trevor Lance asked for a motion to approve the submission of the grant for 96 Wilkie Way.

Councilmember Keith Reed motioned to approve the grant and it was seconded by Councilmember Amber McKinney.

Motion all in favor.

Town Manager Report

On the debris removal in town, we were still trying to get the state and the contractor to remove the stumps. We were not making any progress, and we had public works get an estimate to get this completed. They were able to get this completed, and it cost less than originally estimated. (original \$4,700) I don't have that exact figure at the moment.

I emailed you all recently, and I wanted our Planning & Zoning Director, Tyler Morrow, to spend some time with each of you to hear your perspective on development in town.

The Fire Chief reached out to Tyler Morrow on regulations for gated communities. If we might want to consider our own ordinance to regulate that. How is access allowed and battery backup etc.
