Presentation from Fletcher Youth Baseball.

Mayor Blakely stated that Fletcher Youth Baseball will be here next week to do their presentation.

Donation of surplus property to the Henderson County Sheriff's Office with Resolution R-25-11.

Police Chief Dan Terry spoke on his request that the town donate the 2018 Harley Electra Glide motorcycle to the Henderson County Sheriff's Department.

Council is agreeable to this and this item will go on the Consent Agenda for approval at the regular meeting.

Presentation of plan for extension of Cane Creek Greenway - Ben Cathey, McGill Associates

Ben Cathey of McGill Associates gave a brief overview from last month on the Cane Creek Greenway extension. His recommendation is to work on sections 3 and 4 at this time and if the bids come in really well, possibly add section 1 as well as a bid alternate.

Discussion Followed:

Proposed street resurfacing projects for 2026 and cost estimate - Ben Cathey, McGill Associates

Ben Cathey of McGill Associates is recommending Meadow Pathway Drive, Meadow Walk Court & Stafford Court for paving this budget year. He stated that Meadow Pathway Drive may need more additional work than originally projected and, due to the cost, we may need to move Stafford Court to next year for paving.

Discussion Followed:

Budget process for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 - Mark Biberdorf, Town Manager

Town Manager Mark Biberdorf went over a suggested timeline of the upcoming budget process for next fiscal year. The CIP items have just been submitted to me as the deadline was last Wednesday and I will be going over those. By January, we will be presenting these and giving you a list of recommended items with a new five-year plan. He asked council to check their calendars for the suggested dates that he has on the timeline in the packet.

Revisions to grant guidelines for Stormwater Off-of-Right-of-Way Grant Program - Mark Biberdorf

Town Manager Mark Biberdorf went over some recommended changes to the stormwater grant program that was recently implemented. He stated that he ran them by Ben Cathey of McGill Associates, and he had a couple of things that he recommended be changed.

Discussion Followed:

Council agrees to move this item to the Consent Agenda for approval next week.

Town Manager Report

The filing period for elections (as we tried to get it moved to July by switching to the plurality method) is currently noon on December 1 until noon on December 19.

The Christmas in the Park event is this Saturday from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm. We will have carriage rides, santa and a vendor market.

Councilmember Jim Player mentioned the upcoming public hearing in January and his concerns about the traffic on Pressley Hill Road. He stated that he would prefer that an exit from the proposed business not be coming out onto Pressley Hill Road. Those roads are small and very narrow and the residents do not need the extra traffic there either.

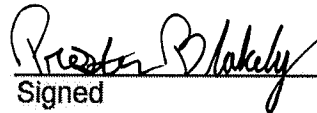
