Town Manager Mark Biberdorf went over his recommendations for the upcoming CIP plan for 2026 through 2031.

Town Manager Report

I shared with you about the state revolving funds that we put our application in for the sewer

project and got turned down because we did not have enough hurricane-related damage. I shared with LOS that maybe we could still apply in another round that is not Helene related for state revolving funds. We maybe could also use some of our unassigned fund balance to cover this project, as we are at 75% in the unassigned balance. Our policy says to keep our balance between 45 - 65%.

In February, we are going to lose this room (council room) due to the elections board using it. We can meet in the multipurpose room, but the police dept has a class in there during this time and there is going to be a lot of setting up and breaking down of the tables and chairs etc. It has been suggested that we have one meeting instead of two in February due to the circumstances.

Council agrees to only one council meeting in February on February 9th in the multipurpose room.

I wanted to give you an update on some issues with The Super 8 motel on Underwood Road, as we have met with the property owner(s) recently as this is a nuisance abatement issue. We met with the owners back on December 16th and we have a Memorandum of Understanding with them to abide by something that would cut down on the illicit activity there. It is not fully executed as yet because some of the owners are out of the country. We are already seeing some small improvements, and we hope this will continue.
