Town Manager Report

Town Center Project

On Lewis Real Estate Group, the next step was a proposal to bring a land planning firm and a timeline for them to update the master plan like a market analysis, and I still don't have that from them yet. I am still waiting but anticipate that it will be any time.

We had a couple of other entities and one submitted something that was a little too much one tenant-focused. I am sure that is not going to go any further at this point.

We did just receive one this past Friday from Southeast Capital Partners, which is another one of the groups that we have been talking to. It has a very good site plan. I am not sharing it yet because we are still digesting it at staff level, and we have some comments and concerns, but, overall, it has a very good layout of the uses per the vision of our project.

On the library project, the county has selected an architect, and it is on their agenda for tonight for final approval. The recommended architect is Clark Nixon, who is a very reputable firm and the county has done a lot of work with them in the past. I still do not have the MOU which spells out what we will mutually agree upon and is our whole course of action. Once I have it I will share it with you.

Discussion Followed:

Fall Litter Sweep: Tyler is organizing a litter sweep to take place on Saturday, September 26, from 9:00 to 11:00 am. So, if you're interested, please put this on your calendar and I will do a black board call to help publicize it. Bags, vests and grabbers will be provided.

On the express design option that DOT is working on, which is where you can get a cost estimate of traffic improvements that might be needed which would be associated with commercial development. We put in a request that would be relative to our town center project. However, this did not get in for September because DOT wanted to do Fanning Bridge

road first. So we will push this out for the next meeting in January to hopefully get this done.

Mayor Blakely mentioned the driving range at Broadmoor and possible issues with golf balls going out onto the highway. He mentioned that Broadmoor was looking at a cost share option with DOT for a net to help with this.
